We encourage you to look into visa requirements as soon as possible, as this is an important step in the planning and pre-departure process. Check with your home country's consulate as well as the host country's embassy to learn more.

All students are responsible for applying for, paying for, and obtaining any necessary visas for studying abroad. The Office of Global Education does not advice on immigration matters and is not responsible if you fail to obtain a visa for your host location(s).
