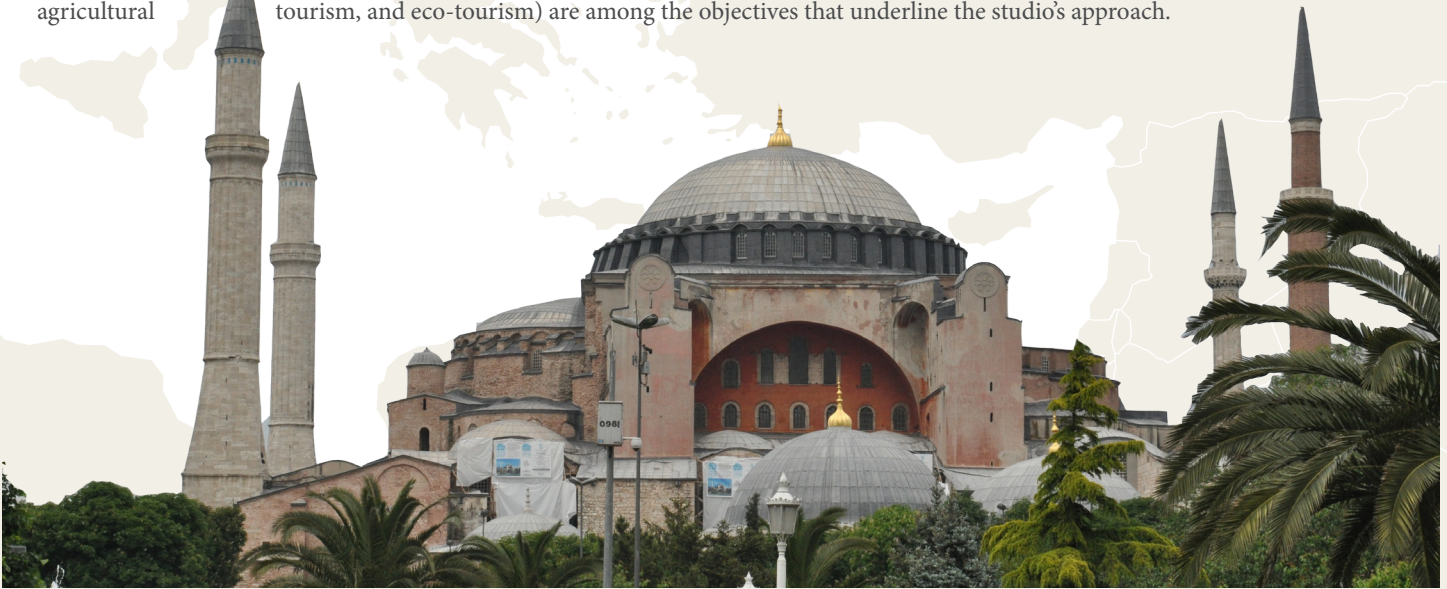

Turkey Planning and Design Studio Abroad focuses on planning in the face of tourism development pressures. Growth management, economic planning, urban design, and historic rehabilitation are major areas of emphasis. Economic diversification; identifying and enhancing place character and identity; defining and encouraging alternative tourism sectors (in particular, food tourism, tourism, and eco-tourism) are among the objectives that underline the studio's approach.



## Planning and Design Studio: Sustainable Tourism in the Slow City Seferihisar, Turkey

### URPL 6910

A brief introduction to Turkish culture and urbanization will be in Istanbul, the biggest city of Turkey. Then the studio will focus on Seferihisar, the first certified slow city in Turkey. Learning from Seferihisar's experience and developing planning and design policies for Seferihisar will be the goal of the studio.

### Learning Objectives:

Understanding a new planning and design culture, its regulations and traditions, contacting various interest groups and grasping the local and national politics will be an important learning outcome. Crafting regional economic strategies, developing land use policies, writing guidelines for creating development codes (form-based codes in particular), preparing detailed urban design schemes for key areas are among the tasks that studio teaching will underline. In addition, sharing these with the local officials and incorporating their input to the proposals will be an important part of the studio work.

### Activities Include:

- Orientation in Istanbul (Hagia Sophia, Blue Mosque, Cisterns, Topkapi Palace, Pera district)
- 6-night Aegean boat tour (Teos, Alaçati, Seferihisar, Gümlü, Samos)
- 2 weeks planning and design studio at Seferihisar, close to Izmir
- Trip to Ephesus
